



Project Description:

The City of Albany will install two planted bioretention practices at the base of a roadway on the southwestern corner of State Street and Broadway, in the City's downtown. Stormwater runoff from the adjacent streets and sidewalks will be directed into these planted beds for treatment.

The project, located just two blocks from the Hudson River, is expected to reduce pollutants and runoff flows to the river through filtration, plant adsorption, evapotranspiration, and a reduction of overall contributing impervious areas.
