

Project Description:

A development known as “I-Square” is underway in the Cooper-Hudson-Titus Avenue neighborhood of Irondequoit, a suburb of Rochester, NY. Described as an “urban town square,” this 92,000 square foot complex will have state-of-the-art green infrastructure, eco-friendly amenities and educational components to help instruct users about its green elements.

The GIGP will fund the installation of rainwater cisterns for harvesting and reusing stormwater, permeable pavement strips in parking areas, rain gardens and green roofs.
