## Project Description:

A green roof was constructed on the plaza level of the Monroe County Civic Center to “green up” and reduce the impervious surface area of this large urban plaza while mitigating stormwater impacts. The green roof will help manage and treat stormwater in this urban center by restoring

a more natural hydrology which will infiltrate, evapotranspire, capture and reuse rain where it falls. A comprehensive retrofit of a large impervious roof such as this helps to keep stormwater out of the local sewer system using green rather than grey infrastructure technologies.
