Project Description:

The New York City Department of Parks and Recreation is in the process of implementing a state-of-the-art LEED-Silver certified recreation facility and other improvements alongside an existing lake in Brooklyn's historic Prospect Park. This new center will be a national model for integrating cutting-edge sustainable architecture

into a public park. The GIGP eligible portion of the project includes the installation of fully accessible green roofs on the new facility.

In October 2012, a dedication ceremony was held to mark the completion of Lakeside's first phase, which includes restoration of historic elements of the park adjacent to the new facility.



Sketch of the proposed recreation center to be constructed in Brooklyn's Prospect Park with green roof systems funded by a GIGP grant. A green roof covering the larger rink will flow into the meadows of the park, providing access to the roof.



Project construction is currently underway on the new state-of-the-art and LEED-certified public recreation center.
