

Project Description:

Part of a larger plan known as “The West Brook Conservation Initiative/Sustainable Advancement of the Lake George Environmental Park,” this project will contribute to a large-scale environmental benefit program which includes green infrastructure improvements to this important regional hub. The project site, a 2.5 acre open-air event space located at the foot of Lake George, will be installed with an engineered soil mixture and then planted with turf. The field surface will then be sturdy enough

to accommodate an annual car show and other regional events, while allowing stormwater to infiltrate into the soils below. As part of the project, a portion of adjacent West Brook Road will also be converted from impervious asphalt into a porous pavement municipal parking lot.

Utilizing porous surfaces in this area will reduce the amount of untreated stormwater runoff entering Lake George, a source of drinking water for the region as well as a tourist hub and gateway for the Adirondack Park.
